



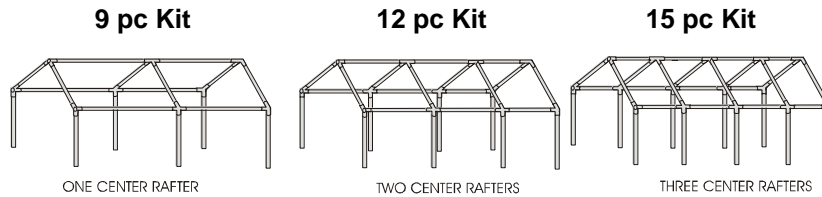

Angle Kit Instructions for MAGNUM Wall Tents

Please note that the cutting dimensions below are approximate. Each tent finishes with slight differences, and some shrinkage may occur after use. Set up tent before use in the field to make sure the frame fits properly. It is important that it does not fit too tight as this may damage the seams and zippers if shrinkage occurs while on the frame. A loose fitting frame can be adjusted using the set screws on each of the angle brackets.

1" EMT conduit should be used to cut your own poles for a completed frame. A miter saw with a ceramic blade for cutting metal works very well to cut the conduit. Be sure to grind down any sharp edges before setting up the frame.

Always secure your tent to the ground using the stakes and ropes provided. Failure to do so may result in damage to your tent and/or injury as a result of wind blowing the tent over.
